Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Sainte-Anne, 2011/12 Languedoc, France Citrusy southern French white made from the Picpoul grape.	£26.00
Pinot Grigio Trentino L'Aristocratico, 2011/12 Trentino, Italy Super example of this popular grape. Flavourful and expressive with zesty fruit and a long lingering finish.	£29.00
Vavasour Sauvignon Blanc Awatere Valley, New Zealand Flaunts a powerful bouquet of fresh herbs, tomato stalk and blackcurrant, layered with ripe stone fruit and bright citrus flavours.	£31.00

ROSÉS

Whispering Hills White Zinfandel £21.50

California, USA

Loads of fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively acidity. Medium-bodied to appeal to most palates. California's own Zinfandel.

Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini £24.00

Veneto, Italy

Dry and subtly flavoured raspberry and apple-scented rosé from the north-east of Italy.

Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence, Château de Beaulieu £26.00

Provence, France

A round full-flavoured style with summer fruit flavours and hints of Mediterranean herbs.

South of France

A rich, juicy southern French wine using this popular variety which originated from Bordeaux.

Callia Malbec, San Juan, 2011/12 £23.00

San Juan, Argentina

Plenty of ripe, soft berry fruit flavours with the usual pinch of spice associated with Malbec as well as cinnamon and vanilla oak-spice notes.

Castell de Raimat Tempranillo Costers del Segre, Spain Tempranillo is rightly regarded as Spain's premium grape variety. This great example is barrel-aged, showing intense dark cherry fruit and a soft, silky texture.	£25.00
Errázuriz 1870 Mapuche Block Cabernet Sauvignon Aconcagua Valley, Chile Mouth-filling blackcurrants and cherries with a gentle vanilla-spice finish.	£26.00
